HEC- NEED BASED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR YEAR 2024-2025

Applications are invited for the HEC- Need Based Scholarship for the under-graduating students enrolled at MNS-University of Agriculture Multan, during Winter Semester 2024-2025. The scholarship will be awarded to those students who are financially disadvantaged and cannot pay their academic dues. The selection of the student will be made by Institutional Scholarship Committee.

Eligibility: -

- 1. Applicants must be enrolled in undergraduate degree programs.
- 2. Candidates must belong to low-income families, with a monthly household income equal to or less than Rs. 45,000.
- 3. The academic performance of applicants must be satisfactory. Poor performance, reflected by a low GPA or CGPA, will disqualify candidates from receiving the scholarship.
- 4. Students are eligible for only one scholarship from the university. If eligible for multiple scholarships, students may choose the one that is most beneficial to them.
- 5. Applicants are required to appear before the Institutional Scholarship Awarding Committee as per the schedule and venue to be notified later
- 6. Penalty for false information:
- 1. Cancellation of admission.
- 2. Rustication from the university.
- 3. Initiation of criminal proceedings.
- 4. Disqualification for award of any future loan/scholarship
- 5. Refund of all the payment received and or a penalty equal to total scholarship amount.

How to apply: -

All the interested and needy students who want to apply for the HEC Need Bases Scholarship admission are encouraged to get prescribed application forms available at the university's photocopy shop (canteen).

- Incomplete application forms not supported by the required documents and/or submitted after the deadline will not be entertained.
- The last date for submission of applications is February 14, 2025.

Documents to be attached: -

- 1. Educational documents from Matric to onwards.
- 2. Income Certificate (verified by the relevant authority):

For agriculture: Verified by the *Ilaqa Tehsildar*.

For government or semi-government employees: A computerized salary slip.

For businessmen, doctors, and advocates: Verified by the Income Tax Officer.

For laborers: Verified by the Administrator/Secretary (with the phone number of the issuing authority mentioned on the certificate).

- 3. Domicile Certificate / National Identity Card of applicant, father and mother
- 4. Current Utility Bills (Electricity, Gas, Telephone, Water)
- 5. Copy of last income tax return (if applicable)
- 6. Attested copy of rent agreement (if applicable)
- 7. Copies of last & latest fee receipts of self and siblings i.e. brothers, sisters
- 8. Copies of medical bills, related documents and expenditure (if applicable)
- 9. Detail of any other scholarship getting form the university
- 10. Any other supporting document required to substantiate the facts given in the application form.
