- 1. Please correct the convocation dates in records.
- 2. In most of the programmes meetings of the statutory bodies are not regular. Please make it possible as per university statute.
- 3. In some programmes the final defense dates of some students are missing.
- 4. In some programmes the degrees of faculty members are not verified by HEC.
- 5. In some programmes the minutes of meetings and notification are not updated.
- 6. In some programmes the notifications of thesis defense are missing.
- 7. In some programmes students admission test results are missing.



Meeting with Students

Students are very satisfied with the education level however they felt some deficiencies which are as under:

- 1. Students needs more Computers for the research activities.
- 2. They want spacious and shaded area at café so they can sit and have their meal in a comfortable way.
- 3. More dust bins should be place in different places so students can use it and make the university atmosphere clean.
- 4. More water cooler should be installed to assess drinking water in a convenient way.

Suggestions/ Recommendations

- 1. Allocation of supervisors should be ensured in the first semester.
- 2. Submission of coursework and synopsis should follow the timeline as per university statutes.
- 3. Regular meetings of Supervisory Committees of research students and documentation in the form of minutes of meetings should be maintained.
- 4. BOS meetings of some departments (SES) are not being held as per approved frequency.
- 5. BOF meetings less than frequency (FAES). Conduct of meetings as per approved frequency should be ensured.
- 6. Admission cancelation notification due to non-payment of dues/fee and/or submission of GS-10 should be issued well in time by the DGS office.
- 7. Steps may be taken towards digitalization of records to ensure facilitation in maintaining and retrieving the data.
- 8. Human resource may be provided to DGS Office to perform various activities/tasks and documentation in a better way.
- 9. Coordination between DGS and Treasurer Office may be ensured regarding exchange of fee submission records etc.
