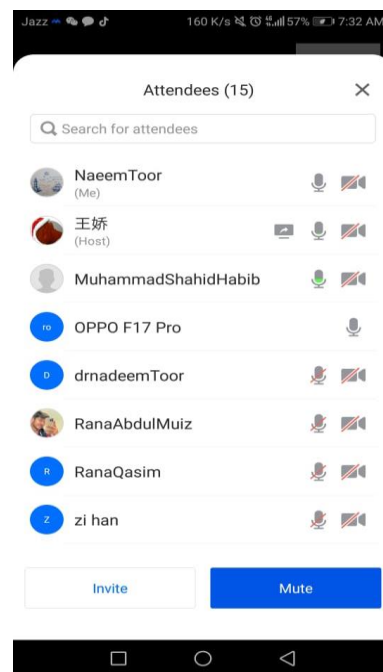
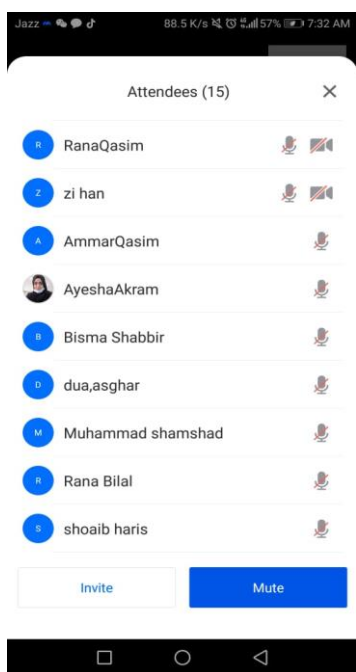


## **MNSUAM Scholarship holders done with mid Exam at HEBEI Institute China.**

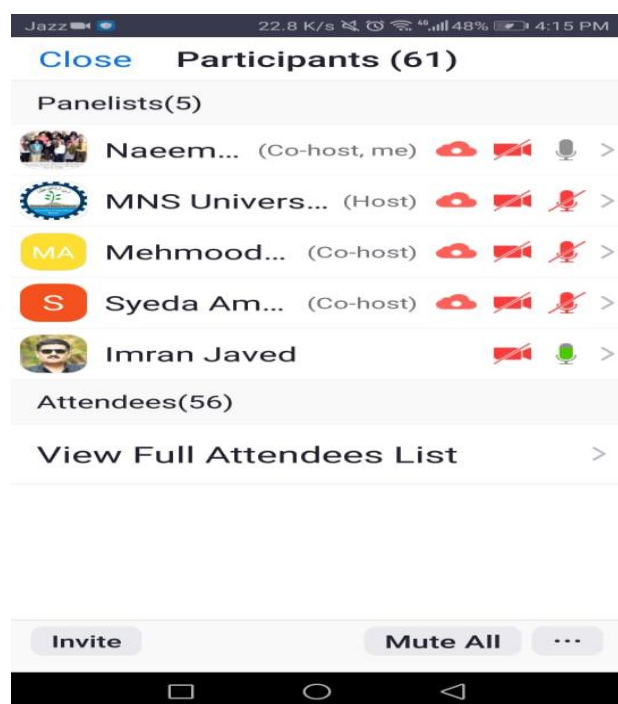


## Social Entrepreneurial Mindset and Pandemic

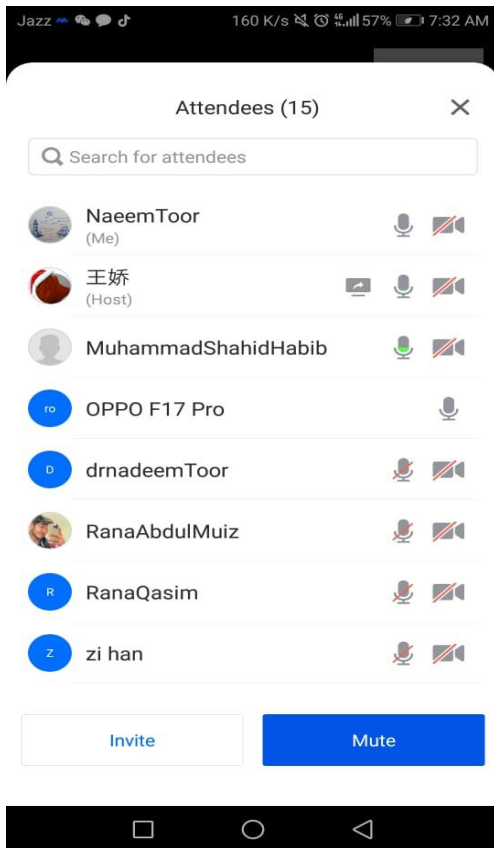

## International conference on Honey bee.

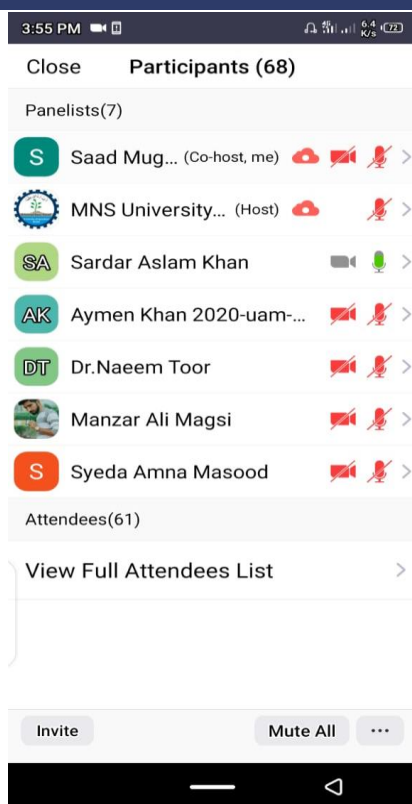
