### Eligibility criteria

- Preferably be a PhD (M.Phil. can also apply) in relevant fields and serving in academic staff in the University in BPS-18 or above.
- Preferably having two years or more of field experience for working as:
  - Working with field wings of Agriculture Department and having interaction with field and farmers.
  - Experience of working with private companies in input supplies and farmers advisory services.
  - Working Experience in farmer field in compliance with donor agencies e.g. FAO, UNO etc.
  - Experience of working as farm manger
- Preference will be given to the supervisors having domicile of the project districts.
- Supervisors should have android phone and well verse with the use of mobile base applications. The internees will be allocated on the basis of the area of operation / tehsil under the respective University.

### Terms & Conditions

- Will coordinate and supervise the selected interns and provide full support to the allotted intern and resolve their day to day issues.
- Review the internee’s work plan and suggest improvements.
- Inspect farmer’s sites for verification of activities.
- Reporting to government and other implementing partners in respect of project activities.
- Review and improve the business model developed by the internee
- Act as the supervisor for all extension and advisory needs for all farmers participating in the Project through the app
- To review and rate the overall performance of the intern
- Advice internee on latest farming techniques to secure more efficient production, higher yield, and improved quality.
- To visit farmers as per the prescribed schedule
- To recommend interventions to cater to adverse conditions any farmer may encounter.
