

MNSUAM The MNS University of Agriculture, Multan (MNSUAM), Centaurus Mall, Islamabad, and Mango Research Institute (MRI), Multan jointly organized the 6th Annual Mango Festival from July 22 to 24, 2022 in collaboration with the mango growers, industry, and other stakeholders. The major purpose of the festival was to showcase diversity in mango varieties, business potential, and value addition in Mango Sector and to brand Multan as "the Mango Capital" of the country. The worthy Vice-Chancellor of the University Prof. Dr. Asif Ali (T.I) along with President Azad Kashmir, Barrister Sultan Mehmood Chaudhary, and Deputy Chairman Senate, Mirza Muhammad Afridi as co- host, inaugurated the festival on July 23, 2022. The President appreciated the efforts of the university in branding the mango festival and providing a business-oriented platform for the well-being of mango farmers. He also appreciated the efforts of MRI, Centaurus, and the mango growers' community for contributing to the efforts of the university. All the stakeholders including political leadership, academicians, researchers, government officials, and industrialists together with mango growers, traders, exporters, suppliers, and service providers actively participated in the event. The farmers got access to high-end market and made significant cash sales at higher prices through the provision of value-added mangoes and also received online orders for future transactions. An overwhelming public response was received

owing to highly attractive, entertaining, and business-oriented activities. The event was open for local communities and families to visit the exhibition and get information regarding more than sixty mango varieties displayed on 13 stalls. Most people got astonished after seeing the large variety in shapes, colors, and tastes of Mangoes, and the opinion that in the past, we had seen only few traditional varieties. Moreover, visitors demanded to regularly plan such kinds of activities to highlight the business potential and opportunities in the dwindling economy of the country.

More than 60 indigenous and exotic mango cultivars being grown in Pakistan were displayed on stalls. More than 30 stakeholders including growers, exporters, and processors displayed their mangoes and their products on stalls. Approximately, 30,000 people visited and participated in the mango festival. Such an overwhelming response and involvement in the Mango Festival from mango stakeholders, government officials, and the local community is very encouraging which demands continuity of the festival in the future.



Seminar on Lumpy Skin Disease.

A one day seminar was organized on Lumpy Skin Disease. Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, MNSUAM took the initiative to talk about gimmicky disease namely Lumpy Skin with students and faculty. Distinguished scientists namely Dr. Sabtain Bhatti, Director L&DD South Punjab; Dr. Muhammad Imtiaz Additional Director, Multan; Dr. Rao Sabir Ali, Additional Director Head Quarters; Dr. Salma Naz, Deputy Director participated in Seminar. Prof. Dr. Asif Ali (T.I), Vice Chancellor during his speech reiterated this much needed seminar and suggested arranging such events in the future. He was of the view that LSD is an emerging threat to the world and it is spreading rapidly in Pakistan. He urged to provide disease diagnostic and treatment services to the farming community. He hoped FVAS researchers will play their lead role to curb this deadly disease which is hampering the development of livestock sector in region. During his speech Prof. Dr. Muhammad Asif Raza, Coordinator, FVAS, thoroughly discussed the factors that cause the introduction, cause and spread of this disease and explained the research done for the disease treatment. It causes fever, nodules on the skin and can also lead to death, especially in animals that that have not

previously been exposed to the virus he further reiterated to work collectively to get rid from on going situation. Sages of the age scientists namely Prof. Dr. Junaid Ali Khan, PO ORIC, Prof. Dr. Shafqat Saeed, Coordinator, Faculty of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences, and a large number of faculty and students attended the event.
