 - Abstract - 250-300 words.
 - Keywords
- Your abstract will undergo double-blind peer review and the results will be returned to you **generally within two weeks**.
- If your abstract is accepted, you will be invited to register for the conference.
- The selected/shortlisted articles will be published in **HEC recognized “Y category” Agricultural Sciences Journal**.
