The 'Innovator Seed Fund Award Distribution Ceremony' happened on 1st of September, 2023. The 30 winners got their hard work paid off at an enormous ceremony at Pak-China Friendship Centre, Islamabad. A total of 65 startups from different regions of Pakistan competed for seed funding of \$35000 and 30 startups were awarded under ISF. HEC evaluated top 4 startups from MNSUAM and they pitched their presentation in front of jury and out of four, MNSUAM 2 Startups (Microbiome Agritech) founder Ammer Qandeel and (Triple Repulsion Motor) founder Umer Farooq and Dr. Muhammad Abid (Supervisor) got award of \$35000 each. Distinguished speakers, Prof. Dr. Muhammad Shahid from Comsat University Islamabad, Vehari Campus, and Prof. Dr. Azeem Khalid from PMAS-Arid Agriculture University Rawalpindi, shared their expertise on soil pollution, its far-reaching consequences, and potential remedies..

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON RESHAPING COTTON PRODUCTION IN PUNJAB-II: LEARNING FROM GLOBAL BEST PRACTICES

On September 28, 2023, the Muhammad Nawaz Shareef University of Agriculture Multan (MNSUAM) hosted a conference, exploring various facets of cotton production, both locally in Punjab and on a global scale. The event commenced with the recitation from the Holy Quran and was officially inaugurated by Vice-Chancellor Prof. Dr. Asif Ali (T.I). Dr. Ali addressed numerous challenges in cotton production and highlighted various projects, both local and international, designed to address these challenges. He expressed gratitude to all participants, including distinguished guests like Dr. Judith K. Brown from the USA and Mr. Li Huaxin from China for their invaluable contributions.

The conference featured several informative presentations, beginning with an overview of the current state of cotton production in Punjab and Pakistan by the Director of CCRI Multan. Dr. Sagir then discussed the critical aspects of the cotton seed system, emphasizing its role in boosting cotton production.Dr. Judith K. Brown presented on "Global Phylogenomics of Bemisia tabaci and Phylodynamic Snapshots in Pakistan," shedding light on this significant insect pest in cotton production from both local and global perspectives. Following this, Mr. Asif Majeed discussed "Whitefly Management," outlining strategies to combat whitefly infestations in cotton cultivation. Prof. Dr. Muhammad Iqbal provided a comprehensive outlook on the "Present Situation and Future Prospects of Cotton Production in Pakistan," while Dr. Javed Iqbal explored the virology associated with cotton production.

The conference not only identified challenges in cotton production but also proposed solutions and innovative approaches inspired by global best practices. Concluding remarks were delivered by Dr. Zulqurnain Khan and Syed Hassan Raza of Neelam Seed. In a consultative session, the cotton committee deliberated on a "Cotton Production Strategy 2024," addressing critical issues such as crop decline, insect control, crop duration, and disease management. The conference served as a valuable platform for reshaping cotton production through informed and strategic approaches.
